Data Collection



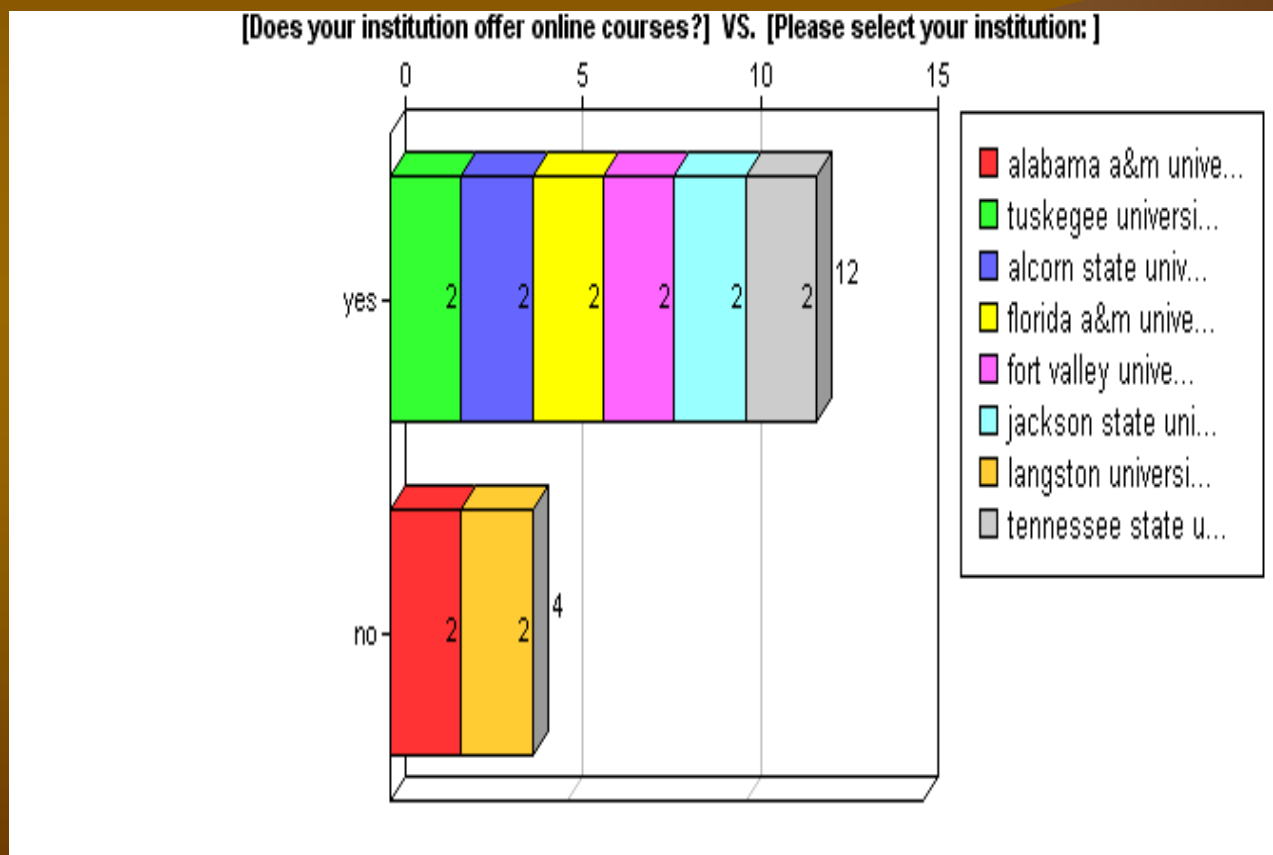
- Instrument borrowed from Gwen Goddard of North Carolina A&T University.
- Request letter including on-line survey link sent to 40 e-mail addresses of proposed ALN Workshop participants.
- 25 responses received with at least one from each of eight institutions.

Data Tabulation



- Only the modal responses of respondents from each of the eight Institutions are reported here.
- To accommodate bi-modal response sets, two responses have been tabulated for each institution for a total of 16 responses.
- Complete sets of responses are available for individual Institutions.

Does your institution offer online courses? Six say yes!

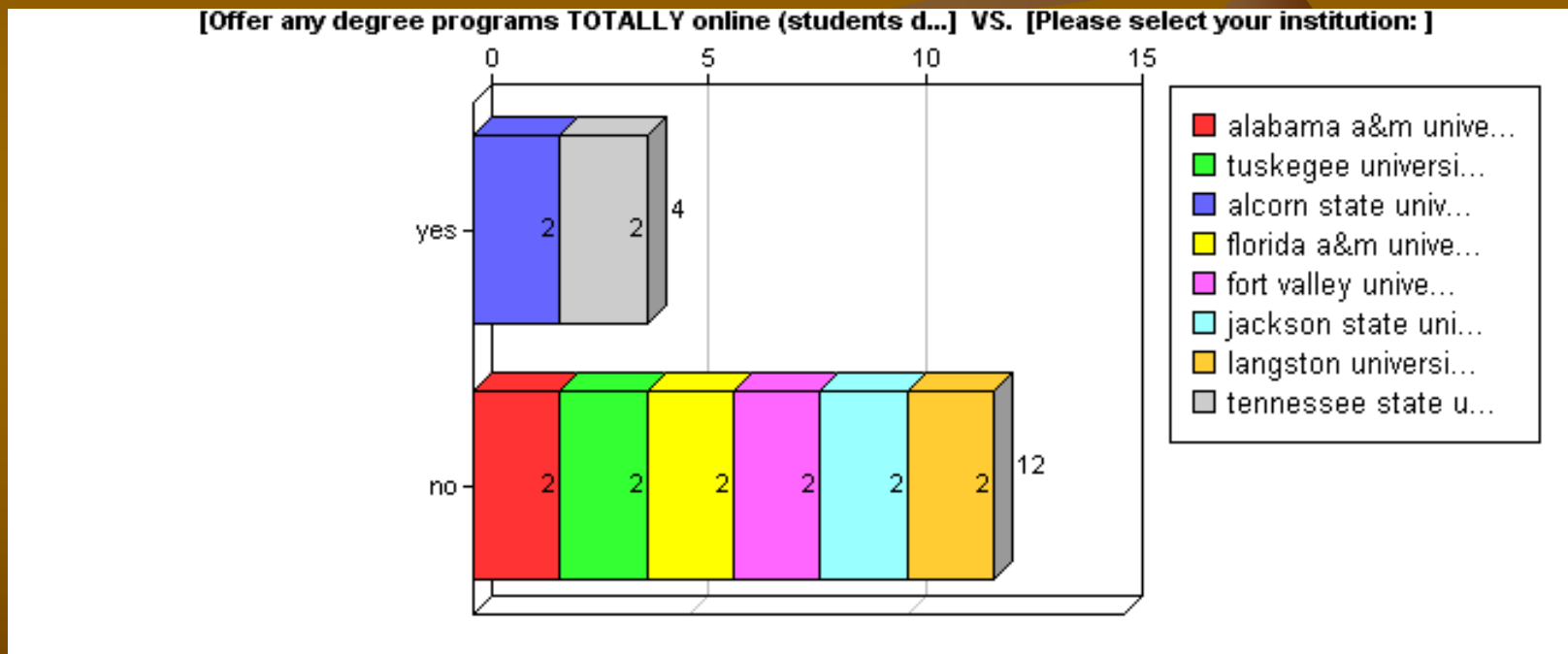

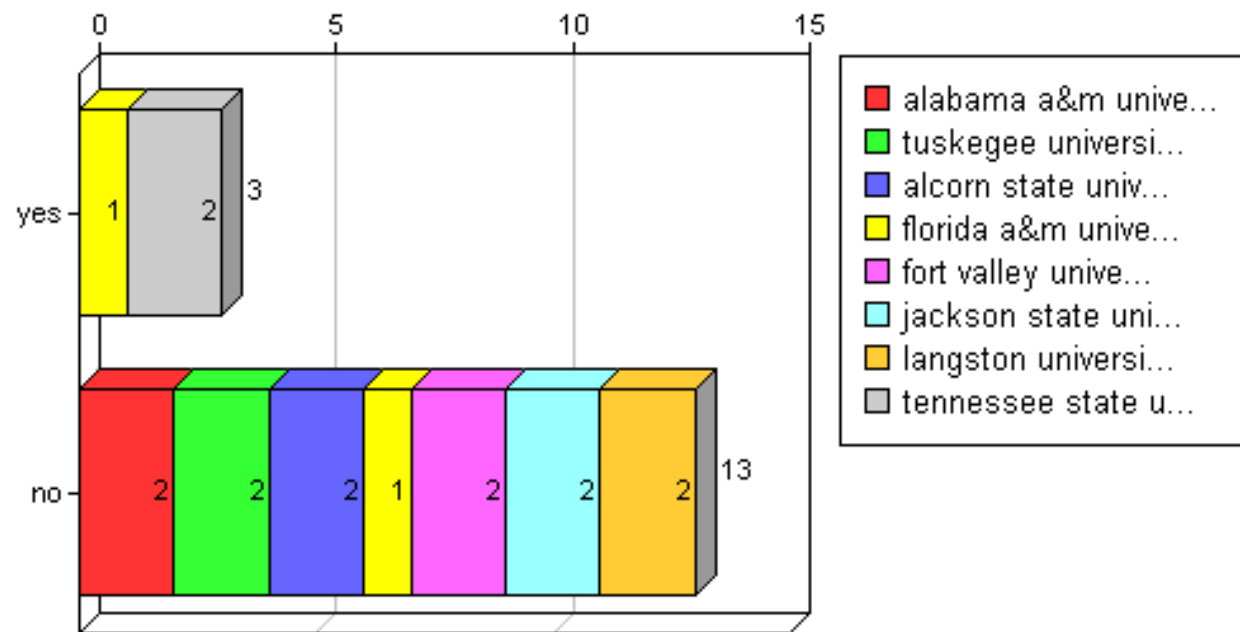

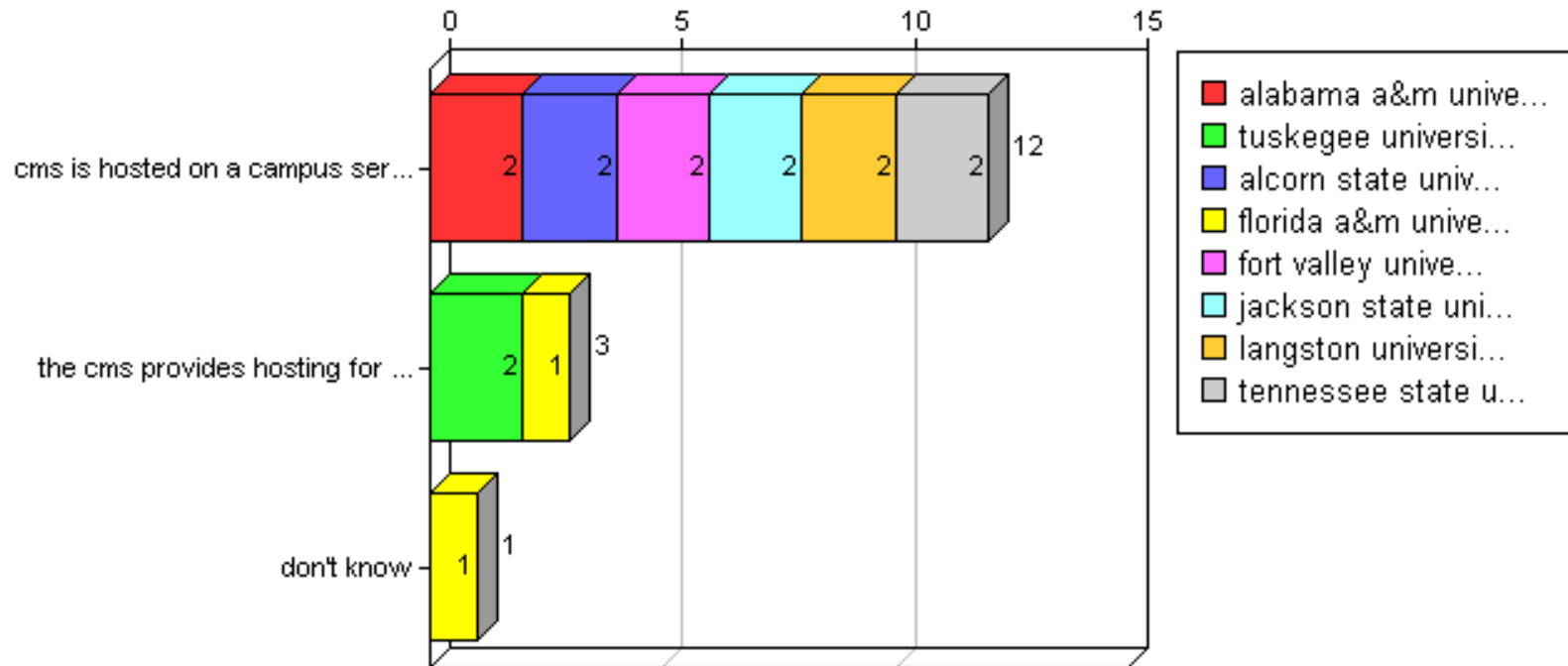

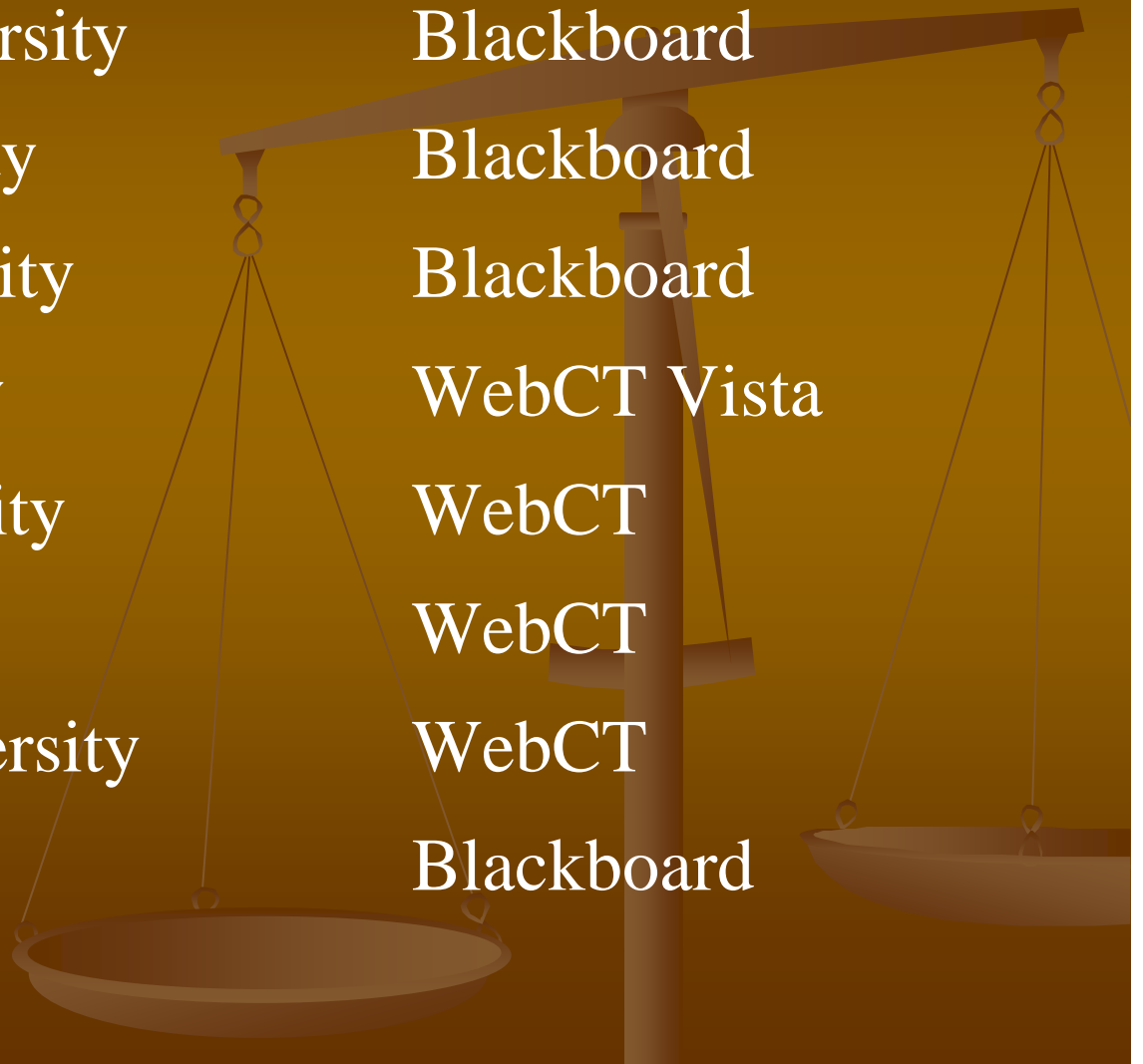

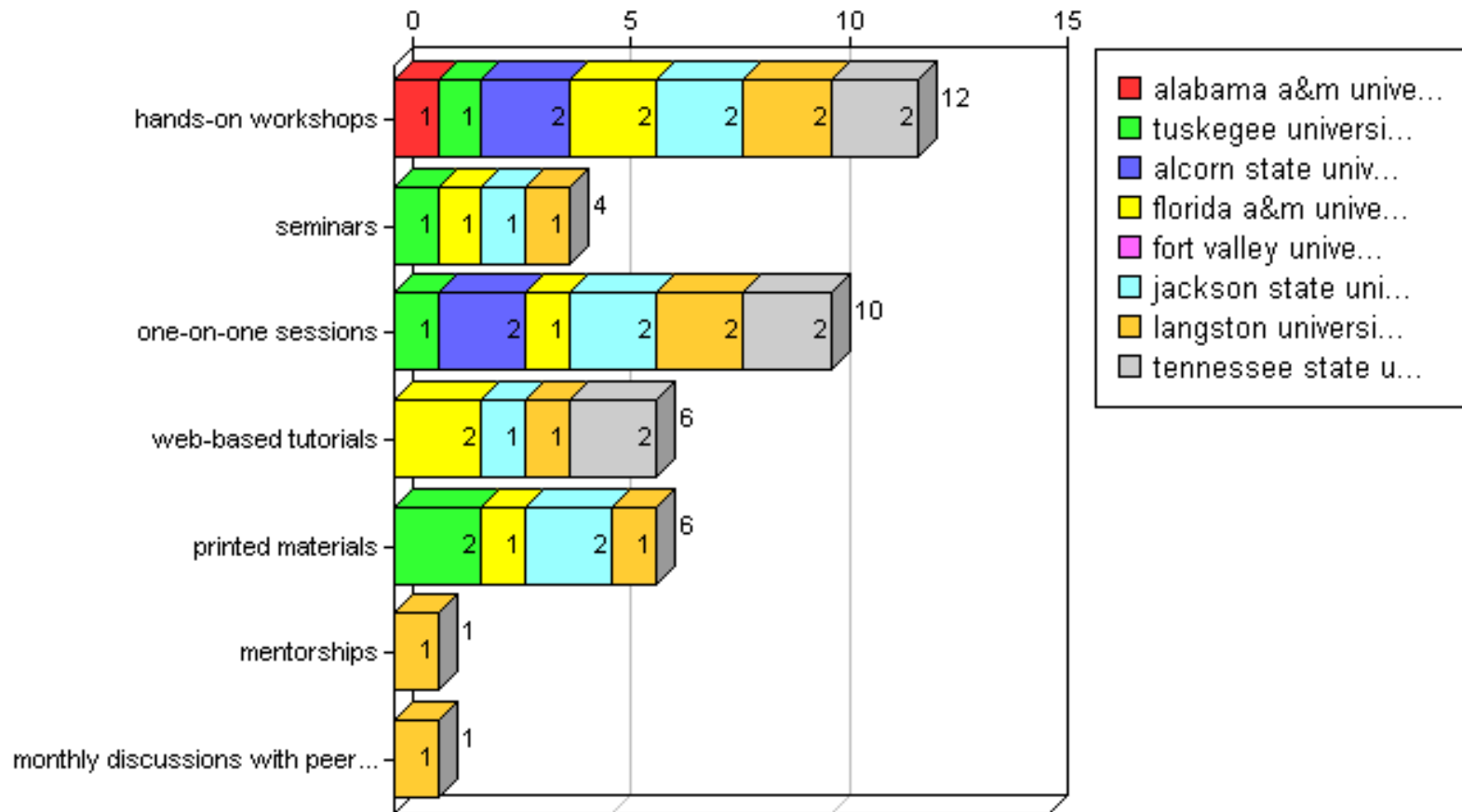

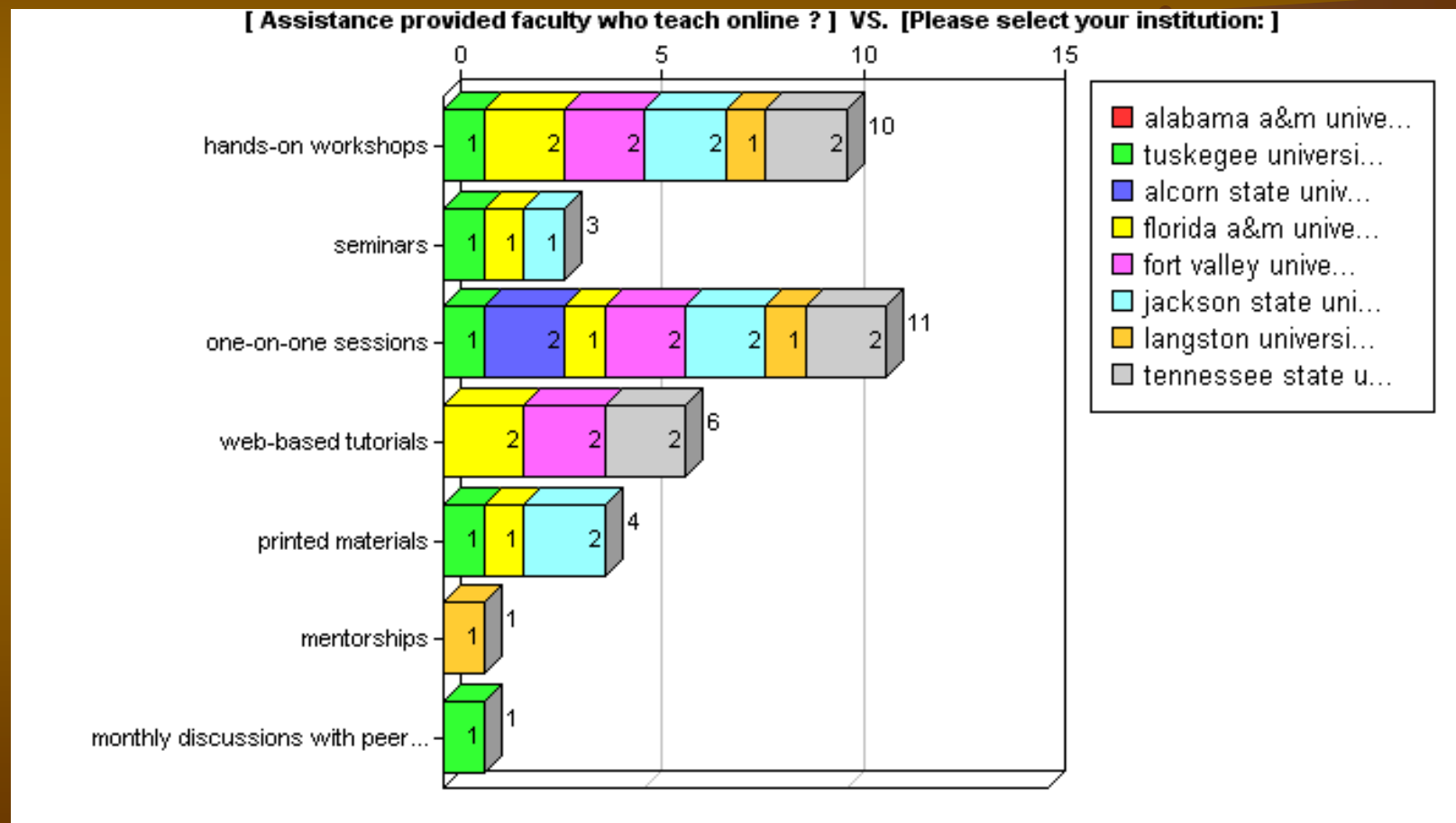


At least four institutions provide hands-on course development training.

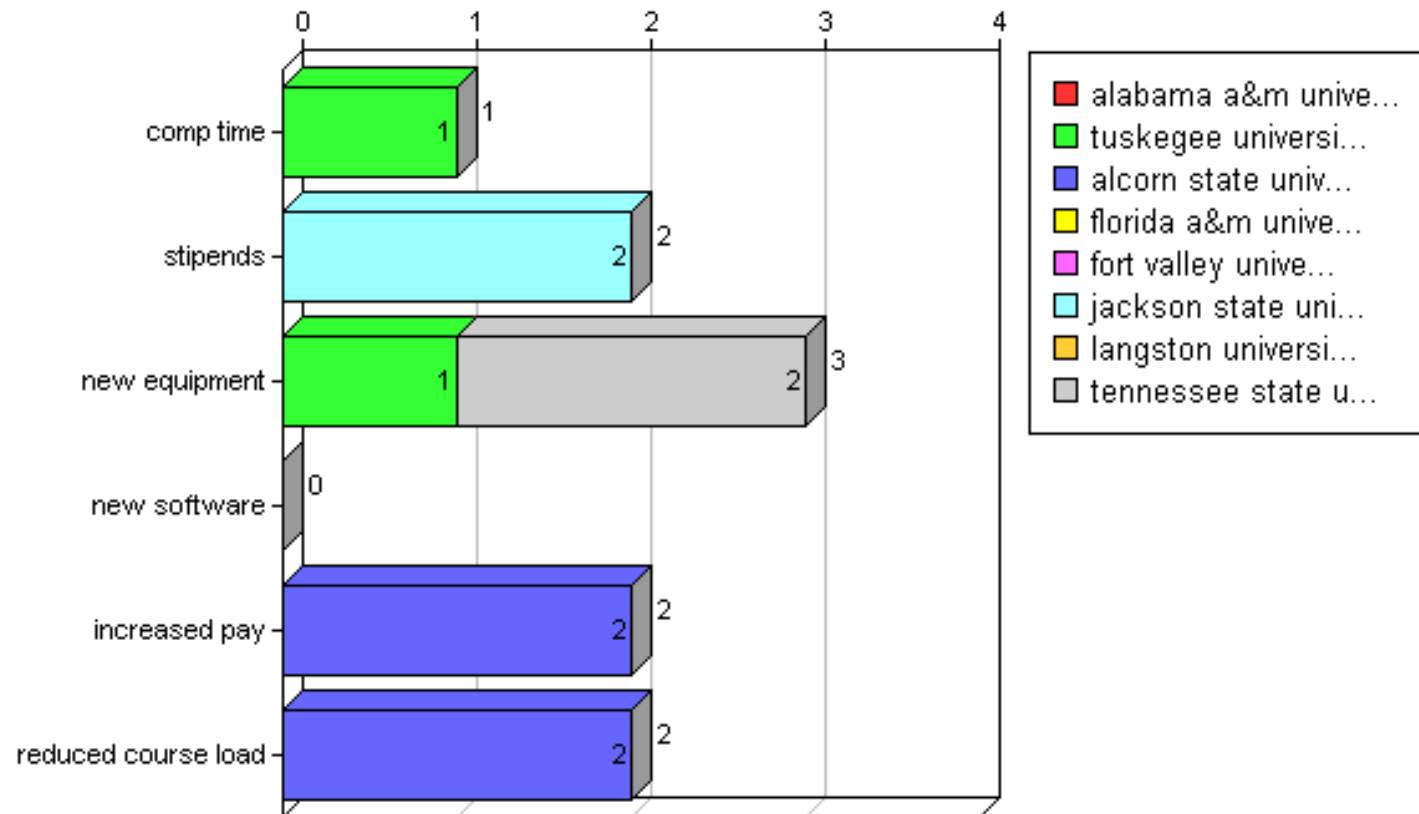


Four provide faculty with one-on-one assistance with on-line teaching.
