

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REVIEWING HONORS ROSTERS

- Look for your name on the roster(s) for the awards(s) for which you believe you qualify. (Tip: Press 'Ctrl + F' to find your name quickly)
- Be sure your name is spelled correctly—this is how it will appear on your award certificate(s) and in the Academic Honors Day program.

CRITERIA FOR ACADEMIC HONORS

All awards are based on a student's full-time enrollment in **regular academic coursework**.

The **PRESIDENT'S CUP**. Any undergraduate student who maintains a 4.00 grade point average for two consecutive semesters, with at least 12 semester hours in the regular academic program each semester, will qualify for President's Cup honors. The recipient will receive an engraved miniature cup.

The **FRESHMAN PRESIDENT'S AWARD**. Any freshman student who obtains a 4.00 grade point average in their first semester of enrollment, with at least 12 semester hours in the regular academic program, will qualify for the President's Award. The recipient will receive a plaque.

The **DEAN'S LIST**. Any student who has attained a quality grade point average of 3.00 or better (scholastic average of "B" or above), has earned no grade below "C", has carried a minimum of 12 semester hours, in the regular academic program and had no disciplinary restrictions for the semester, is eligible for the Dean's List. It is compiled at the end of each semester. Effective January 2008, only ONE certificate will be awarded to recipients. For example, if you obtained Dean's List honors for Spring 2007 AND Fall 2007, you will no longer receive two certificates.

The **HONOR ROLL**. Any student who achieves an overall (cumulative) quality point average of 3.3 and above, and has been enrolled in a minimum of 12 semester hours per semester in the regular academic program for at least two consecutive semesters, will qualify for the Honor Roll.

The **FRESHMAN HONOR ROLL**. Any first-time freshman who achieves a grade point average of 3.3 and above, with a minimum of 12 semester hours in the regular academic program after one semester, is eligible for the Freshman Honor Roll.

*Eligibility for Freshman Honors is determined each semester, based upon a student's academic performance for the preceding fall or spring semester.
